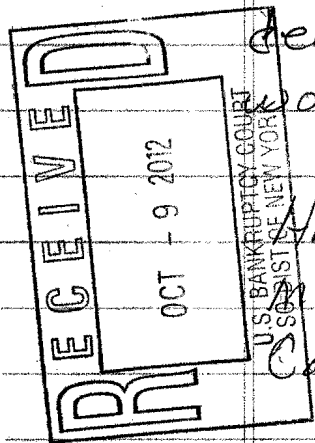
I think the court should be held in our Area. This is where the people ~~are~~ lived-worked and died. Many of death was on the job, & they should & would not die in vain.
