- 4. Escitalopram Depression
- 5. Clonazepan Panic attacks, can't leave house or drive, in terrible condition without
- 6. Crestor Cholesterol
- 7. Lavaza Triglycerides
- 8. Hydroxyzine My mouth and face swells very large, and throat can do the same, I look terrible when my lips hang down, and doctors not sure if they can return to their normal size. It is a scary situation.
- 9. Flonase Allergies
- 10. Vitamin D 50,000 units prescribed by doctor for bones

The following is what my husband takes:

- 1. Metformin Diabetic
- 2. Nexium Reflux
- 3. Citalopram Nerve medication
- 4. Lisenopril Blood pressure
- 5. Simvastation Cholesterol
- 6. Flonase Allergies

The visits to the doctor's office, hospital, and all medication are covered by this insurance plan that we have with Patriot Coal and Silverscript. If we lose the insurance that we have with "Patriot Coal," we will lose everything. By this, I mean we would have

no life. We cannot make it without this insurance. It is critical to our daily lives. My husband, who is a retired coal miner, and I both live on a limited and fixed income and would not be able to afford these prescriptions on our own. We cannot stress this point enough. We need your help, so please do not let this happen and help us to keep from losing our insurance.
