My wife is in a nursing home at this time and we totally rely on this insurance to help in her situation. If we lost our healthcare, I would hate to think what happen to us.

My wife and I are pleading with you to please move this case to Charleston, West Virginia where the UMWA can participate in the bankruptcy proceedings whether it is in New York City or St. Louis. We are very dependent on this insurance and would like to be able to keep it or something comparable.
