I begin my career in mining in 1967 at the age of 18 years old. At that time, the hard working miners agreed to work under the "Cradle to Grave" agreement where we were paid lower wages, paid in union dues and thus benefited from having the peace of mind that our families would always be provided health coverage.

I provided for my family for many years through Peabody Coal before I became the victim of a mining accident. I suffered multiple back, hip and leg injuries which prohibited me from ever returning to work not only in the mines but any occupation.

Today I suffer from kidney disease along with other multiple health problems. The medication I am required to take to prevent me from going on dialysis is very expensive to say the least. Enclose is a copy of the medicines that I take daily. Without my coverage through Peabody Coal Company, I would not be able to afford the buy the medications that I need. I just found out last week that I have a blockage in my kidney that is making my kidney function deteriorate. I am in level 3 of kidney failure and if they can't remove this blockage I'm will be on level 4 of kidney failure and when it goes to level 5 I will need to be on dialysis.

Please give careful consideration to your decision and the impact that it could have on many families and communities.
