again, I don't know if I have to have another surgery. The insurance is the only thing to pay the huge bills.

3 years ago my back was getting so bad I was having trouble walking and standing to cook.

They put rods and pins in my L3-L4 + L5 disk. The doctor said it was pinching on my spinal cord I would have been paralyzed before long. It was a long time healing and physical therapy to get me moving.

If we loose our benefits I could never afford the treatments I need.

Please help us to


