We live on my retirement from EACC and Peabody Coal and social security. We have no extra. As for Health Care and Hospitalization, myself I have Medicare and BCBS from where I retired from, Peabody Coal, and their contract with the UMWA. MY dependents, Wife and 2 adopted children only have Blue Cross Blue Sheild health Insurance, from Peabody COAL under the UMWA contract. We cannot afford to loose this Ins. We should not. And I never even worked for Patroit Coal. And I live very close to the same Preparation Plant and Mines that I retired from, and they are still in operation, and producing coal every day. I pray that you will see what this bankruptcy is all about, and do the right thing. This kind of behavior of Gaint Corperations is whats wrong and destroying our economy. Please, Please, take a deep and hard look at Patroit Coal's Restructering Bankruptcy. I pray that you can find it in your mind and heart to not let Peabody&Patroit Coal do away with retired miners pensions, health Ins., widows and childrens health Insurance. They signed a contract and they should have to abide and live up to it. Like I said, I never worked for Patroit, only Peabody. May "GOD" BE WITH YOU AND HELP YOU MAKE THE RIGHT DECISION.


