The Honorable Kathy A. Duratt - States

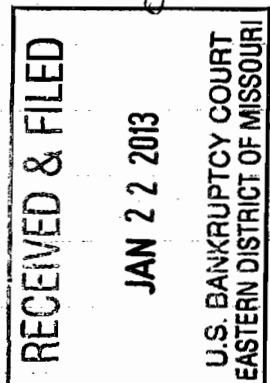

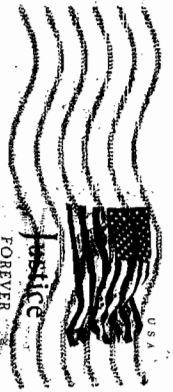
