My name is Larry R Hicks and have worked 27 1/2 years in the Coal Mines, All underground.

I have 25 1/2 years working for Eastern Associated, Peabody Coal, and Patriot Coal, under the United Mine Workers of America.

In all negotiations we were promised health care for me and my family. I will be seventy years this February. My wife will be seventy years old in July.

This bankruptcy, Peabody, Patriot will leave myself and my wife in extreme financial difficulty. Our out of pocket medical expenses cannot be met if this action is approved.

I gave the company 25 1/2 years of my life assured myself and my wife would have medical
