On January 14th I wrote you concerning Patriot Bankruptcy case No. 12-51502 in your court. Since that time my wife has been busy composing letters to US and state senators and representatives pleading for their help in requiring Peabody to step up to the plate and pressure Peabody to finance their creation Patriot Coal Company, (created solely to dump their contractual health and welfare obligations to retirees whose labor and loyalty made them the largest coal producer in the world). That loyal labor made the large profits that Peabody now wants to use to move into a other countries to exploit those labor markets by using the courts of our land for their own greedy use. During this period of collecting information and letter writing it seemed clear that this information should also be sent to you and enclosed are copies of the letters along with the names to whom sent.

As told in our first letter I retired at 68 years in 1995 after 43 years with Peabody (after they purchased Will Scarlet Mine where I had been employed since my return from Korean War service), which was 13 years prior to Peabody's creation of step-child Patriot. All those years worked no lost time accident and many of those years faithfully working 7 days/nights/evenings always arranging contractual time off in advance with the company causing my wife to call Peabody my mistress. Therefore, Peabody's actions toward me can only be compared to tossing out an old and faithful spouse for a young floozy lover.

The loss of contractual Peabody health care will make it necessary to pay for drug insurance which would cost us in one quarter about as much as has been spent on my wife and I in the past 10 years. Having to purchase supplemental medical insurance would take away the money that has given us a few luxuries, like having monthly massage and acupuncture treatment and purchasing whole food vitamins, homeopathic and flower essences to keep us healthy at 84 ½ and almost 78 years. It will take away money needed to replace a broken appliance or dining out and making worry about entertaining friends and family visiting. However, for a great majority of retirees this would mean they could not pay their utility bills, keep up the home and car insurance or even have money for food and medicine. This means that many retirees would become burdens on the state governments, while the officers of Patriot and Peabody can vacation in resorts at \$3000 per night.

An investigation into the incomes of the boards of these companies in total should be compared to the total cost of the Health insurance expenses for retirees and employees. You have the power and resources to learn this information, which we do not. While it may be legal for officers in a bankruptcy to escape without having to put their assets into the pot, it is immoral, unethical and unjust. "Commit the act, pay the penalty". What is penalty? It seems clear that money is the goal, so money should be the penalty.

While we all know that life is unfair, our system of government was built on the idea of "law" as a blindfolded woman holding the scales of justice. When Corporations put iron weight on one side of the scales the whole system begins to collapse and that is being reflected in America's drop in position in comparison to other industrial countries. This must be halted or the land "of the free and the brave" will become the land of "Lords and serfs" with the courts used as whip to keep the serfs in line.

In closing, America is built on workers. Your own court could not survive without workers to type, mail, answer phone, empty waste cans, scrub the toilets, mop the floors, clean the snow off the walks and parking lots and then to outside next group of workers, sanitation, utility, and so on to every level of our society. These workers should not be subject to the whims of corporations who will promise anything to keep profits in their hands while knowing they can renege in the future and use the courts to assist.

Your court holds the reins for the future of our land. We beg and plead with you to give these workers their rightful due. In respect and honor, we are,

You are aware, I am sure, of Peabody Coal Company's fake created step-child Patriot Coal Company's bankruptcy procedure, which was filed in New York, a non producing coal state, but the judge transferred to St. Louis, MO the home of Peabody Coal Company and its step-child Patriot, created in 2007, transferring all debts and no assets, was designed to fail and rid Peabody of contractual obligations which allowed them to post a 2.1 billion dollar 3rd quarter 2012 earnings representing 6% increase in sales over 20 II while Patriot posted a 49.5 million dollar loss for the same period. I worked 43 years never having a lost time for Peabody and never a moment for Patriot Coal created 13 years after retirement and my contract was with them, not Patriot, and it doesn't make sense they could even be thinking this is possible!

Pressure needs to be brought to bear on Peabody Energy Holding Company to finance their step-child Patriot and stop this bankruptcy procedure since only 12% of retirees are Patriot retirees (and most of them spent working time with other companies), while 49% is Peabody retirees & 39% is Magnum Coal retirees, information from Patriot's own data. Of the retires, 18% of these retirees are Illinois miners, 8% Indiana 23% Kentucky, 38% West Virginia, with 13% designed as "other".

It hardly seems likely that Congress intended this creative type of bankruptcy when laws were enacted. It is time for Congress to represent the best interest of every working person and see that Corporations abide by their contracts and not take on the dress of a Despot King of those evils of the past such as Henry VIII and Adolph Hitler, and thus destroy the premise that our country was founded on "laws not whims".

I am mailing this letter to all Senators and Congressman in Il1inois, Missouri, where the hearing will be held on January 29,2013 and Indiana, Kentucky and West Virginia asking that you come together as a group to change this situation. Cost of doing this will be well over one hundred dollars I can ill afford but America has reached a watershed, and we must step up to the plate or we will be attending the funeral of our Blindfolded Lady Justice, as our system of "law not whims" falls to Corporation Despots, an our nation falls into a Medieval way of life.

If as elected representatives of the people you fail to act for them, then complaints that one hears more and more about our political system may just end up becoming" the straw to break the camel's back" to all our ruination. A country is only as good and strong as the body politic treats all the members. This bankruptcy is just the tip of the iceberg of what could happen if allowed to continue. Peabody has an obligation to keep contractual promises instead of using the money to go around the world using up other workers in their effort to acquire more and more wealth. Peabody needs to be required to financially back their step-child Patriot who is spending 8 million dollars on lawyers in this bankruptcy effort! Thank you for protecting people from tyranny but moving to stop this injustice and sending a message we are not a country about to become a victim of Corporate despotism.
