I am currently employed at Patriot Coal High land Mine at Waverly Ky with 30 1/2 year pension credit. When Peabody Coal was growing in 1974 I was hired at Peabody Coal Baldwin Mine 8-1-74 as an underground employee. I worked there 20 years working mostly at the face area on dusty jobs. The mine closed Dec 3. I had 20 year pension credit. On 8-11-2003 I was recalled from Peabody's panel to Peabody's Highland #9 Mine at Waverly Ky as an underground employee again working at the face area in dusty conditions. At both locations I agreed to work for wages, benefits, and Health Care which I planned on for retirement. Peabody agreed to contracts and memorandum of understanding (MOU) agreements at Baldwin and High land #9 Mines.
