MY NAME IS Ron Chambers  
My wife and I are one of the  
Thousands that will be effected by  
the Patriot Coal Corporation effort to  
dump its UMWA Retirees and their  
dependents, also destroying the current  
Collective Bargaining Agreement at  
active operations.

I started in the Mining Industry in 1979 knowing there was  
danger as well as health risks involved  
in this accupation however the wages  
were decent and the Family Health  
plan was great, my Father had worked  
many years in the mines and had died  
of Complications to Black Lung 30 yes  
I did know there was a lot Risk  
involved but to be able to Feed,  
cloth and provide my family with  
Health care I jumped in.

When I Retired in 2006 I had  
20 plus years with Hobet Mining and  
Never doubted that my wife and I  
wouldn't have our Health Care, after  
all the company had Signed the BCOA

agreement which gave us our  
health care but this was shattered  
when we learned that Patriot coal  
was attempting to break their word  
go back on their promise and just  
dump thousands of Retirees, widows  
and their dependents and also alter  
the current agreement at active oper-  
ations.

I understand that my wife and  
I are only one number in thousands  
that would be effected if Patriot  
should be allowed to break their  
promise but I wanted to tell our  
story in November of 2012 I was  
diagnosed with Stage 3-B Lung Cancer  
since surgery was not a viable  
option the other choice I had  
was combination of chemo and Rad-  
iation treatments, Jan. 12, 2013 I  
completed a series of 30 Radiation  
and 6 Chemo treatments, now I have  
to wait 4-6 weeks have a CT scan  
to see if it helped or not. Now  
to have the Doctor tell you that  
you have Stage 3 cancer in it  
self is devastating but then add the  
fact that Patriot is using every

trick in the book to do away with  
our Health care which we so desp-  
erately Need to fight this cancer as well  
as our other Health Needs.

The bottom line is if Patriot  
is allowed to break the agreement and  
is allowed to dump us, where we have  
worked hard all these years and managed  
to have a few things, if my cancer  
treatment plan doesn't work and the battle  
last very long this will all be gone  
and the sad part is the real victim  
will be my wife and family, the ones  
left behind to pay the bills and pick  
up the pieces always suffers the  
most.

There is something wrong with  
a system that would allow a group  
of CEO's to gather in a back room lay  
out a plan to bungle all the union  
Retirees in one group, had to know  
it would fail thereby destroying the  
lives of thousands of hard working  
people and their families, I am ask-  
ing they not be allowed to do this,


