My husband worked for Peabody Coal Co. for nearly 30 years. Every pay check was from Peabody Coal Co. He retired under the 1974 Contract in 1993. The miners union UMWA bargained for the miners. Contract promised medical coverage for retiree + widows.

We no longer can count on this. My first bill was when I had a prescription filled. In 2012 my cost was \$13.15. Now its \$53.15.

A miners pension after 30 years of work is \$632.72 a month. The 1974 Contract promised medical coverage. We are all fearful of our future.


