I am a seventy two year old male. I started work for Peabody Coal Company in 1971. I worked at Camp 11 before being laid off in 1995. I filed for disability twice and was denied both times. I have had surgery on my right carotid artery twice. Two weeks after the second surgery, I was diagnosed with diabetes. Two years ago I was diagnosed with prostate cancer and had surgery for it. I now have neuropathy in my legs and feet. I also have a blockage in my aorta.

I take four shots of insulin daily. I also take thirteen pills a daily for my high blood pressure and neuropathy. Due to the medication I have less than normal kidney function.

In November of 2012 I had the misfortune of losing my wife to several medical conditions. Since her passing I have stopped receiving her Social Security which was a large part of out income.

I would appreciate if you could help me keep my pension and medical coverage that was in the contract under which I retired. Thank you very much your honor.


