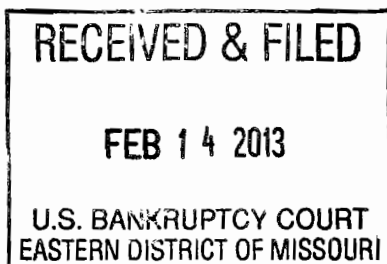
Your Honor,
