Our insurance is very important. I've had several medical problems. I have 2 stents in my heart. I've had 3 tumors removed from my bladder, 1 known-malignant, and 2 malignant. They monitor my bladder every 6 months. I've lost one kidney to cancer and they monitor the other kidney every six months. My wife has had some problems, she has 2 stents in heart, one to a kidney, and one to each leg. These are the reasons we're worried about as we do need our insurance.
