Just how valuable is our insurance?  
I will be as brief as possible.

In October 1996 my wife, Mary Ruth, was taking medication for diabetes and she had a heart attack, which is sometimes hard to detect of diabetic persons. She had to have an aorta repair, an artificial heart valve and an aneurysm repair of the left ventricle.

Everything went successfully.

In December 1996 a so called blood infection occurred. She had to be air-lifted to Missouri Baptist Hospital where she was given strong antibiotics for 5 days.

Finally, the out-come was again successful.

After all of these occurrences she had to start insulin shots.

In 2007 a wound open on her left leg which finally healed. Then in 2008 the same thing

happened to the right leg. This  
time things didn't go so well...  
she passed away July 25, 2008.

I am sure you can imagine  
the cost - I DID NOT SEE A  
BILL - THANKS TO THE INSURANCE  
PROVIDED.

I would be destitute today  
if it had not been for the  
coverage.

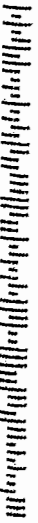

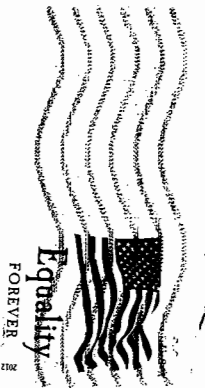
