The treatments are expensive. I get a shot of medicine every three months in the eye. I've had this since 2006. Without the insurance full or long term treatment doesn't work possible.

I also have lost hearing in my left ear due to Menieres disease. No real help available.

With these ailments and my age employment is not likely to be mine. With the loss of the pension \$335.75 monthly my income would be \$957.00 per month not much to buy insurance and most of the companies if the cover will have time riders on existing conditions. I would really appreciate your consideration of my self and others as you make your decision.

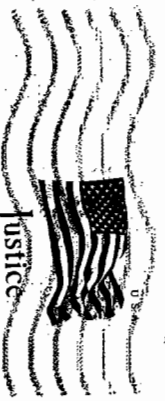
