My wife Ruby is 72 years of age. She is diabetic, high blood pressure. She takes 4 insulin shots each day. Between the two of us ~~we~~ we take a lot of medicine.

Our income is less than \$2,000.⁰⁰ a month. There is no way we could pay for our medicines if we lost our healthcare.

I hope you will consider all of the people who have worked in the mines and those who are working in the mines today expecting a pension and good healthcare in retirement years.

I hope you will think on these situations when making your decision.


