Before Peabody Coal, I worked for Republic Steel in Chicago. years after I left it became LTV Steel. All my coworkers suffered the fate I now face, no pension or healthcare as promised.

I moved back to Ohio County Ky. to work for Peabody Coal Co. Ken Surface mine that was owned by Kennecott Copper Corp. The U.S. monopoly laws were applied to force a sell. After the sell, the attitude of upper management changed toward the union employees.

I worked lots of overtime hours and paid days I could have taken off. I worked 24³/₄ years and all pay checks were from Peabody Coal Co.

Peabody had mines named patriot when Patriot Coal Corp. was formed, most upper management were peabody people. They could manage to thrive or fail, they managed to fail.

Peabody land in my area is being mined by Armstrong Coal Co. I think peabody formed it also, but I can't prove it. Most management and foremen are former peabody people. I hear the hourly workers get the peabody magazine. Most days I hear two trains of coal leave this mine.

My wife, who has always been a housewife, and I are in our 70's, without promised pensions and healthcare, our future looks very disturbing.
