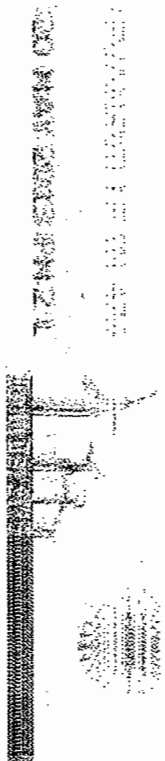
Your Honor
