**SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER ON DEBTORS'  
FIFTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO CLAIMS  
(Wrong Debtor or Otherwise Inconsistent with Books and Records)**

On June 20, 2013, Patriot Coal Corporation and its subsidiaries that are Debtors in these jointly-administered cases (the "Debtors") filed their Fifth Omnibus Objection to Claims (Wrong Debtor or Otherwise Inconsistent with Books and Records) (the "Objection").

On July 26, 2013, the Court entered an Order sustaining the Debtors' Objection [Docket No. 4376] (the "July 26 Order") except as to certain Adjourned Claims, as defined in the Order. On August 22, 2013, the Court entered a Supplemental Order [Docket No. 4506] (the "August 22 Order") sustaining certain Adjourned Claims. The Debtors have since resolved certain remaining Adjourned Claims. Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:


1. As to the Claims of the State of Michigan, Department of Treasury (E.D. Mo. Claim Nos. 200 and 206; GCG Claim Nos. 196 and 202), the Objection is SUSTAINED.
2. As to the Claim of the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services (E.D. Mo. Claim No. 2300; GCG Claim No. 3670), the Objection is SUSTAINED.
3. As to the Claim of Tire Centers LLC (E.D. Mo. Claim No. 1347; GCG Claim No. 1972), the Objection is SUSTAINED.

4. The following Adjourned Claims are ADJOURNED to October 22, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. (the "Adjourned Claims"): Continental Bank (E.D. Mo. Claim No. 2304; GCG Claim No. 3674); Hulin H. Cook, Jr. (E.D. Mo. Claim Nos. 3257 and 3299; GCG Claim Nos. 3725 and 3726); and David Cox (E.D. Mo. Claim Nos. 1787, 1788, 1787-1; GCG Claim Nos. 2783, 2785, 2784).

5. The Clerk of the Court and the Debtors' claims agent are hereby directed to reflect the relief granted herein in their respective records.

6. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 3007(f), this Order is a final order with respect to each Claim disallowed hereby.

7. Nothing in this Order shall affect any other claims addressed in the Objection.
