On May 15, 2013, Patriot Coal Corporation and its subsidiaries that are Debtors in these jointly-administered cases (the "Debtors") filed their Third Omnibus Objection to Claims (Paid and Satisfied Claims) (the "Objection").


On June 19, 2013, the Court entered an Order sustaining the Debtors' Objection [Docket No. 4169] (the "June 19 Order") except as to certain Adjourned Claims, as defined in the June 19 Order. Certain Adjourned Claims have been resolved. Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Objection is SUSTAINED as to the Claim of Mead Johnson & Company LLC (E.D. Mo. Claim No. 971; GCG Claim No. 1562).
2. The Objection is SUSTAINED as to the Claim of Southern Indiana Gas & Electric Co. (E.D. Mo. Claim No. 2581; GCG Claim No. 2015).

3. The Clerk of the Court and the Debtors' claims agent are hereby directed to reflect the disallowance of such Claims in their respective records.

4. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 3007(f), this Order is a final order with respect to each Claim disallowed hereby.

5. Nothing in this Order shall affect any other claims addressed in the Objection.
