THE OLDER I GET I AM NOW 64 YEARS OLD

GET AROUND ANY MORE OR HAVE ANY FRIENDS  
MY CONCERN IS I CAN'T TAKE CARE OF MYSELF  
AND WILL HAVE TO GO INTO NURSING HOME AS

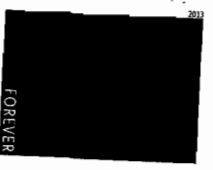
