**AMENDED ORDER REGARDING DEBTORS' TWENTY-SECOND
OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO CLAIMS
(Cyprus Creek Vendor Lien Claims)**

On October 25, 2013, Patriot Coal Corporation and its subsidiaries that are debtors in these jointly-administered cases (the "Debtors") filed their Twenty-Second Omnibus Objection to Claims (Cyprus Creek Vendor Lien Claims) (the "Objection"). Capitalized terms not defined herein have the meanings set forth in the Objection.

In light of the Objection, Creditors Bentley Badgett II, Linda Badgett, Donald Bowles, and Betty Bowles (the "Creditors") desire to withdraw the Claims. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 3006, withdrawal of a claim after the filing of an objection requires an order of the Court after a hearing on notice to the Debtors and the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors. The Debtors consent to the withdrawal of the Claims by the Creditors, and the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors is no longer in existence.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. The Claims listed on Exhibit A to the Objection are hereby deemed
WITHDRAWN.
2. The Objection is OVERRULED as moot.

3. The Clerk of the Court and the Debtors' claims agent are hereby directed to reflect the withdrawal of the Claims in their respective records.

4. This Amended Order supersedes the order entered on November 20, 2013 as Docket No. 5033.
