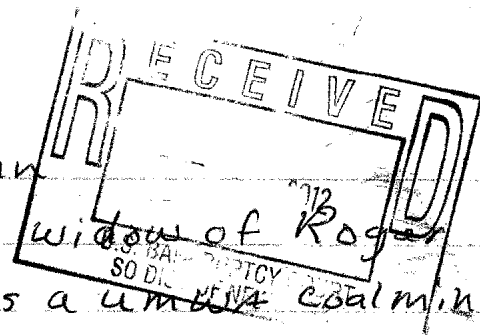


Dear Honorable Shelly C. Chapman

Williams who worked for 30 years as a ~~umwa~~ coal miner for District 17 Local 5850. He was disabled and passed away on 2-1-2008. Like a lot of coal miners he had a lot of injuries to his body and Black Lung.

So I think that it is very wrong of Peabody Arch and Patriot coal to take our healthcare and Pension check. And to file Bankruptcy in New York and not in West Virginia where the coal mines are and where the coal miners worked and died for our healthcare and Pension checks. Please search your heart and move the case to Charleston W.V. where it rightfully belongs. Please I am begging you on behalf of all coal miners and Retirees Widows everywhere to rule against the wrong that Peabody Arch and Patriot coal are trying to do to us. I have had cancer and had to have 28 Radiation treatments, I have to see one of my doctors every 6 months if I lose my healthcare I won't be able to see any doctor to get the care I need to stay well.

And if Peabody Arch and Patriot coal takes away my umwa Miner's Pension I won't be eating because I have to have a Home to live in and a car to get around in my check helps to pay my electric and water Bills and insurance payments on my Home and car and my Property Tax and other Bills I have to pay

in 2011 I had to do a lot of repairs to my Home and now I don't have any Heat in my house I am trying to save enough money to get that fixed before it gets too cold. If Peabody Arch and Patriot coal take our healthcare and Pension check the Retirees and widows won't be able to live I know this doesn't have anything to do with this case Arch coal did my husband wrong when he became disabled they held out evidence and objected to all evidence and wouldn't let Worker's Compensation pay his disability benefits Arch coal got away with that wrong now they have teamed up with Peabody and Patriot coal so they can have more power to hurt a lot of Retirees and widows Peabody Arch and Patriot coal don't care if we live or die as long as they get what they want. Please Honorable Shelly E. Chapman rule for the UMWA and Retirees and widows and move the case to Charleston, West Virginia Due to health reasons I can't attend the Hearings.
