Please think about all the yrs. he worked so hard for his Pension + Health Care ins.

Let me tell you about some of the sickness + Problems that our 2 Children + me have had. + if it had not been for The Health ins. I don't know how we would have paid for them.

Our 2 Children, a daughter + a son, Our Daughter had many colds, accidents when she was at home. Our son had Respiratory problems + everytime it would cloud-up + clamp, I was on the road taking him to the doctor, this was going on from 6 mos. + until he left home, he had accidents, + the Health Care paid for it all, he had to get his Appendix took out when he was 13 yrs. and again I don't know what would have happened with out it, because all the things that happened to our kids, I know what could've happened, we would not have been able to pay for everything had we not had The Health Insurance, but I am Thankfull that we did

have insurance to take care of the Bill.

My story, here of late I have been having Problems with my Knees & back. I had both Knees replaced, & then in December 2012 I had fallen & broke my Knee Cap, I had to have surgery on that knee - twice in 3 weeks, after the surgery I had to walk on a walker for 2 1/2 months & that cause my hip to mess up, so now I'm going to the doctors for my back hurts all the time & sometimes I have a hard time getting up just to walk & after I get started walking I still have a lot of Pain, and I'm so glad we have a Health Card & Plan that will pay for all of this, I have problems breathing I take Meds for that, High Blood Pressure. I can't clean my house anymore, I can't do a lot of things but I'm glad all the medical bills are paid if it wasn't for the insurance taking care of all the bills I would be in trouble, I probably would not be walking right now, these are some of the problems I have. My husband Jimmy has been sick, & hurt in the mines a few times, right now he is seeing Doctors with his back, Both Knees, he has lost a lot of hearing in both ears, he wears hearing aids, he has shortness of breath & all of this is & has been paid with the Health Card, he got hurt in the Coal mines in 2002, & that accident got his knees messed up.

So see if it wasn't for the Health insurance

And His Pension, we would be hurting Bad, because we need the 2 things to survive.
